The month of May in Tasmania is cool, so come prepared for all seasons while visiting our 'Treasure Island.'





## TOURS

### **Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2009 Tour 1**

#### **Shopping and Attractions Day 9am to 2.30pm**

We now journey to Latrobe, a township known for its Antique Shops and its unique Reliquaire something that needs to be seen to be believed. Here you can browse the shops and take in some lunch at your own expense. From here we journey back to Burnie. *Cost is \$40-00 per person*

### **Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2009 Tour 2**

#### **Burnie and Surrounds 9am to 2.30pm**

This morning we travel to Ridgley where Guide Falls are viewed and the Alpaca Farm is toured with a chance to purchase products from their shop.
